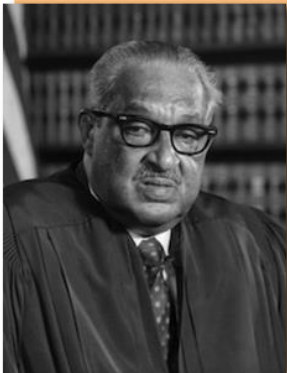

A Home for the “Gentle Giants”



Massive redwood trees have graced the coast of California for thousands of years, yet it wasn’t until October 2, 1968, that Redwood National Park was founded to protect these “gentle giants” as national treasures. After the discovery of gold along the Trinity River in 1850, Northern California experienced a mini-gold rush, and many miners turned to logging, which decimated the redwood population. The outbreak of World War II led to a construction boom, and once again the trees were eyed as a rich source of lumber. It was not easy for President Lyndon Johnson to sign legislation establishing Redwood National Park, but thankfully, 58,000 acres of forest were set aside for preservation.
