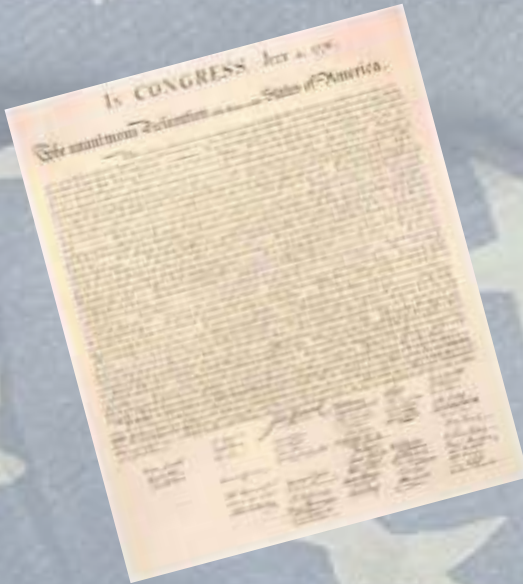

Independence day fun facts

- **Thomas Jefferson drafted the Declaration of Independence on a “laptop,” a kind of writing desk that could fit on one’s lap.**
- John Adams and Tomas Jefferson both died on July 4, 1826. Davis explained, **“that may be the most extraordinary coincidence in all of history. On the 50th anniversary of the adoption of the declaration the two giants of the declaration both died. Jefferson died first. Adams was alive, of course, in Massachusetts. He didn’t know that Jefferson had died but said, famously, perhaps apocryphally, that ‘Jefferson still lives.’ People took that to mean his words will live forever.”**
 - The Printed version of the Declaration was called the Dunlap Broadside— 200 were made but only 27 are accounted for. One of these was found in the back of a picture frame at a tag sale and sold at auction for \$8.14 million to television producer Norman Lear. It now travels the country to be displayed to the public.
- **Jefferson’s original draft was lost and the one eventually signed is the “engrossed” document and is kept at the National Archives.**
