Did You Know? St. Patrick's Day

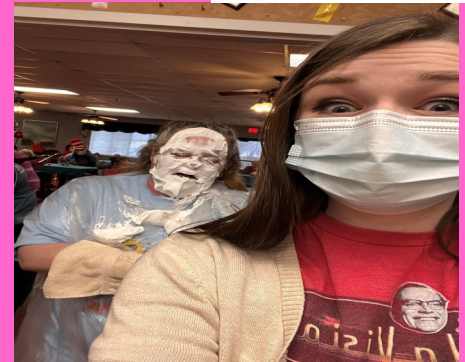
- St. Patrick (who St. Patrick's Day celebrates) is not actually Irish. He was originally from Wales, but later became the patron saint of Ireland. March 17 is the accepted day of his death.
- The first St. Patrick's Day parade took place in New York City in the 1762 when Irish soldiers paraded festively through the streets.
- For most of the 20th century, pubs in Ireland were closed on St. Patrick's Day since it is considered a national holiday.
- For many years, blue (not green) was the color associated with St. Patrick. It was only until the late 18th century did the color green become associated with St. Patrick's Day, as it was linked to the Irish independence movement.
- St. Patrick's Day is celebrated all over the world, even in parts of Asia and the Caribbean.
- Traditionally, each year, the Irish leader hands a crystal bowl full of shamrocks to the U.S. President. It is immediately destroyed by the Secret Service after the exchange.
- Why shamrocks? Legend has it that St. Patrick used the three-leaved plant as a metaphor for the Holy Trinity when he was introducing Christianity to Ireland.
- Nearly 11 million pints of Guinness are consumed around the world on March 17.
