Resident Spotlight

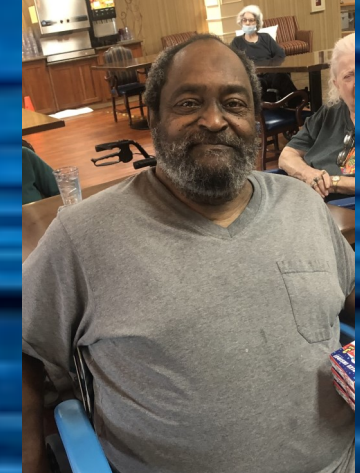
