NHC Town and Country Visitation Guidance

- Visits must be pre-scheduled to ensure the safety of visitors, patients, and staff. (No exceptions)
- Visitors must be aged 14 or older. No younger children can visit at this time.
- Visits are limited to 2 visitors per patient, per visit.
- Visitors must be screened upon entering the facility. Visitors will not be allowed to visit if they have a fever above 99.5 degrees F, signs, or symptoms of illness, or known contact with persons infected with the COVID-19 virus.
- Visitors must sign the visitation waiver and release agreement prior to the start of the visit.
- Visitors must wear a facemask for the entire duration of their time at the facility. If you do not arrive with a facemask, one may be provided for you as supplies permit.
- Visitors must use proper hand hygiene either by washing hands with soap and water or by using alcohol-based hand rub when entering the facility and prior to leaving the facility.
- Visitors must maintain social distance of at least 6 feet between themselves and all other persons including staff and patients.
- Visitors can enter the facility for screening only. All visits will take place outside on the back patio. Visitors are not allowed to enter any other part of the facility including patient rooms. Exceptions may be made for patients receiving hospice care.
- Visits may be cancelled due to inclement weather including, but not limited to, temperatures above 85 degrees F and present or impending rain. In cases of inclement weather, we will attempt to reschedule your visit as soon as possible.
